The use of free vitamins in cosmetic formulations, especially α -tocopherol, retinol and ascorbic acid, is seriously limited due to their high instability in creams, milks, serums, gels and most preparations.


Retinol is the primary naturally occurring form of Vitamin A and is particularly renowned for its anti-ageing properties. It is particularly effective in preventing skin damage induced by UV radiation, one of the main causes of premature ageing.

Actives


- Retinol: Vitamin A
 - Supports mitosis and thickening of epidermis
 - o Enhances enzyme activity
 - Regulation of keratinocyte terminal differentiation
 - o Modulation of collagen synthesis



- Retinol (Stabilised) Delivery system: from phosphatidylcholine (soy bean)
 - o Improvement of bioavailability through penetration
 - o Moisturisation
 - o Anti-ageing



Stability of Retinol




Same vial for all measurements - no nitrogen or photo protection.

Stability of Stabilised Retinol in a Formulation




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
Efficacy Study

20 volunteers aged 37 to 64

28 days
Wrinkle depth (PRIMOS)
